Tom 'It was cool when the ropes came down from the sky.'

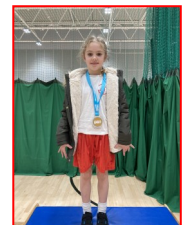
Harry D 'I loved it when the beach balls were flying around.'
